0	Rt 660	Take Rt 660 W out of town N 41' 44.864 W 077' 18.139
Note: Follow Rt 660 W 4.5 miles from Wellsboro to the Potter-Tioga Visitor Center		
2.9	Rt 362	Junction of Rt 362, continue straight on Rt 362 W N 41' 44.036 W 077' 21.165
7.3	Rt 362	Pass Darling Run Public Access Point for the Pine Creek Rail Trail N 41' 44.217 W 077' 25.734
8.1	Rt 6	Junction of Rt 6, turn left onto Rt 6 W
8.2	Rt 6	Arrive in Ansonia
8.5	Colton Point Rd	Turn left onto Colton Point Rd, located after the tavern, and continue up a winding mountain road N 41' 44.812 W 077' 26.001
11.6	Colton Point Rd	Barbour Rock Trail is on the left, a mile-long handicap-accessible trail to a magnificent vista overlooking Owasssee Rapids N 41' 43.390 W 077' 27.353
12.6	Colton Point Rd	Main entrance to Colton Point State Park N 41' 43.007 W 0077' 27.808
12.8	Colton Point Rd	1st Canyon vista overlook on the left N 41' 42.492 W 077' 27.918
13	Colton Point Rd	Continue straight, road becomes gravel N 41' 42.397 W 077' 27.994
13.6	Colton Point Rd	4 Mile Vista N 41' 42.082 W 077' 28.267
14.4	Colton Point Rd	You will pass Rexford Trail N 41' 42.304 W 077' 29.980
14.9	Painter Leetonia Rd	Turn left onto Painter Leetonia Rd (mileage sign "Leetonia 12 miles") N 41' 42.273 W 077' 29.529
16.7	Painter Leetonia Rd	Turn left onto West Rim Rd N 41' 41.417 W 077' 28.972

18.2	Painter Leetonia Rd	Pass Seimons Trail on the left, O'Conner Trail on your right N 41' 41.337 W 077' 28.750
20.5	Painter Leetonia Rd	Pass Little Slate Run N 41' 39.920 W 077' 29.388
21.3	Painter Leetonia Rd	Pass Little Slate Run Vista on your left N 41' 39.908 W 077' 28.521
22.7	West Rim Rd	Turn left onto West Rim Rd N 41' 38.908 W 077' 28.781
23.2	West Rim Rd	Pass an unnamed vista on the left N 41' 39.088 W 077' 28.291
23.6	West Rim Rd	Pass the Bradley Wales Rd, keep right to continue on West Rim Rd N 41' 38.829 W 077' 28.229

At this point you can choose to travel down Bradley Wales Rd to the lookout and picnic area. The road is a mile and will end at the picnic area. Be sure to adjust your mileage accordingly.

27.3	West Rim Rd	Pass Spinning Wheel Vista on your right N 41' 36.600 W 077' 26.882
28.2	West Rim Rd	Pass Mine Hole Rd on your right, Pine Trail on the left N 41' 36.659 W 077' 26.194
29.3	West Rim Rd	Pass Steel Hollow Trail N 41' 35.966 W 077' 25.392
33	West Rim Rd	Pass an unnamed vista looking into Blackwell on the left N 41' 33.857 W 077' 23.475
34.2	Rt 414	Stop sign and the junction of Rt 414 N 41' 32.925 W 077' 23.311

Option 1: Turn right onto 414 W and continue toward the villages of Cedar Run, Slate Run, Cammal, and Waterville. From 414 W, turn left onto 44 S toward Waterville. Turn left onto Little Pine Creek Rd (you will see a sign for Little Pine State Park). Follow Little Pine Creek Rd to junction of Rt 287 in English Center. Turn left onto 287 N to continue back to Wellsboro.

Option 2: Turn left onto 414 E to travel through Blackwell and into the town of Morris. At the intersection of 414 and 287, turn left to go Rt 287 N. You will travel 287 for approximately 11 miles back to Wellsboro.

NOTE: Rugged terrain that may be difficult to navigate during inclement weather. These roads are dirt and gravel and are windy, narrow, and slick when wet. There is no winter maintenance, no service stations or rest areas.
