Small Towns & Scenic Byways



Start Point: Galeton, PA
Total Distance: 50.6 miles

Enjoy a leisurely drive exploring the byways north of historic Pennsylvania Route 6 in Potter County that takes you through delightful small towns, wooded landscapes, and offers opportunities to stop at popular visitor spots like Denton Go recreation area, the Pennsylvania Lumber Museum, downtown Coudersport, historic Galeton, and other stops. Perfect for a summer drive, fall foliage adventure, or throughout the year as a relaxing way to experience the beautiful byways of Potter County!

Total Mileage*	Road	Description GPS Coordinates
0	Rt 6	Start at the intersection of Rt 6 and Bridge St 41.73571° N, 77.64288° W
11.3	Rt 6	Head West on PA Route 6 to Denton Hill (Denton Go) on the left and the Pennsylvania Lumber Museum on the right 41.77828° N, 77.82766° W
22.1	Rt 6	Continue to follow Rt 6 W over Denton Hill to Coudersport 41.77460° N, 78.02101° W
25.1	Rt 44	At the stop light turn right and head north on Rt 44 to Rt 49 41.81457° N, 78.00923° W
25.1	Rt 49	Continue straight onto Rt 49
35.7	Rt 49	Follow Rt 49 through Colesburg to Rt 449 41.87199° N, 77.83769° W
43.1	Rt 449	Turn right onto Rt 449 (N Brookland Rd) and continue south to Rt 6 41.78934° N, 77.76425° W
50.6	Rt 6	Turn left onto Rt 6 and head east back to Galeton 41.73571° N, 77.64288° W
